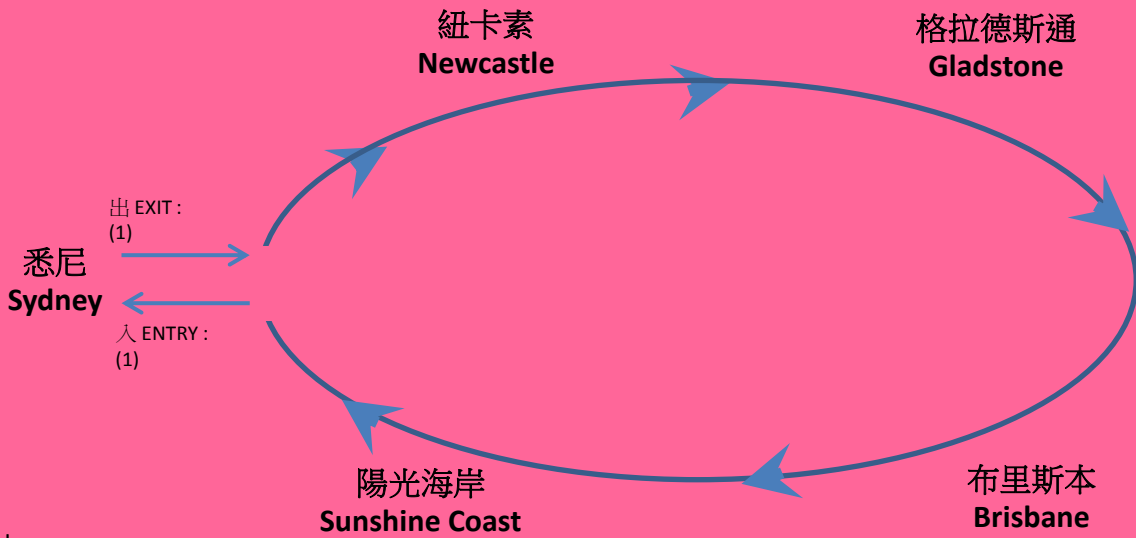

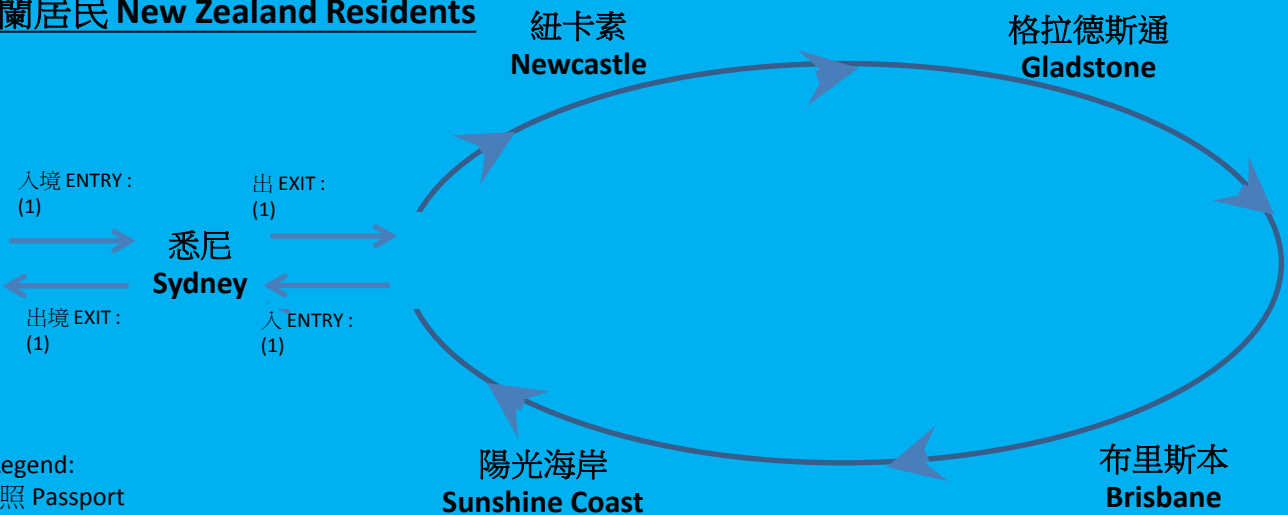

(1) 護照 Passport / 附有相片的身分證明文件正本 Original Identity document bearing photograph

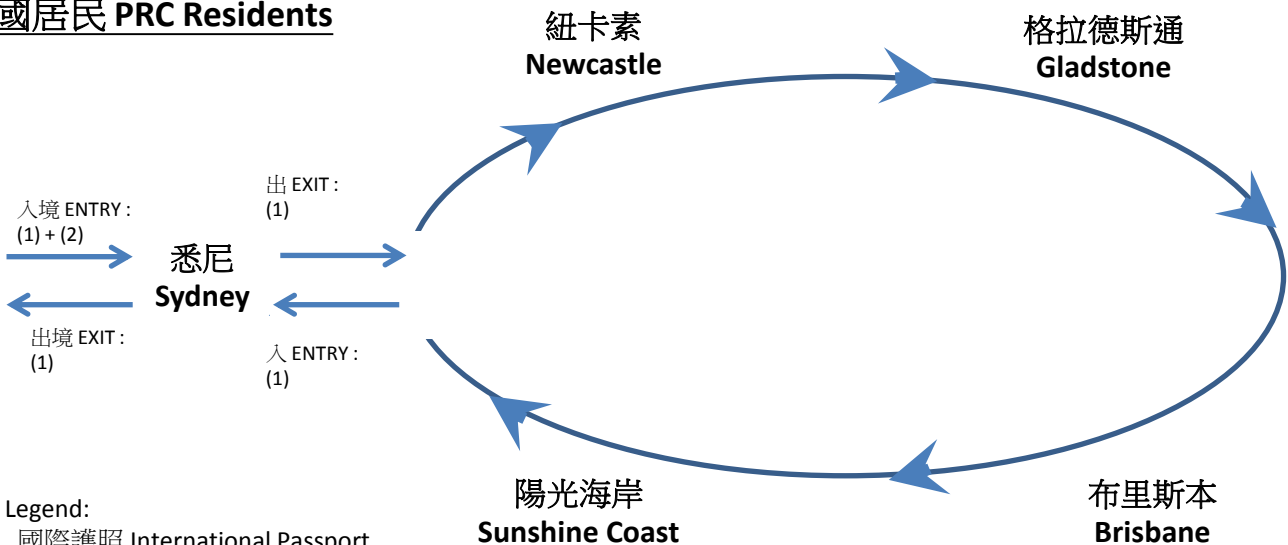
新西蘭居民 New Zealand Residents

(1) 國際護照 International Passport

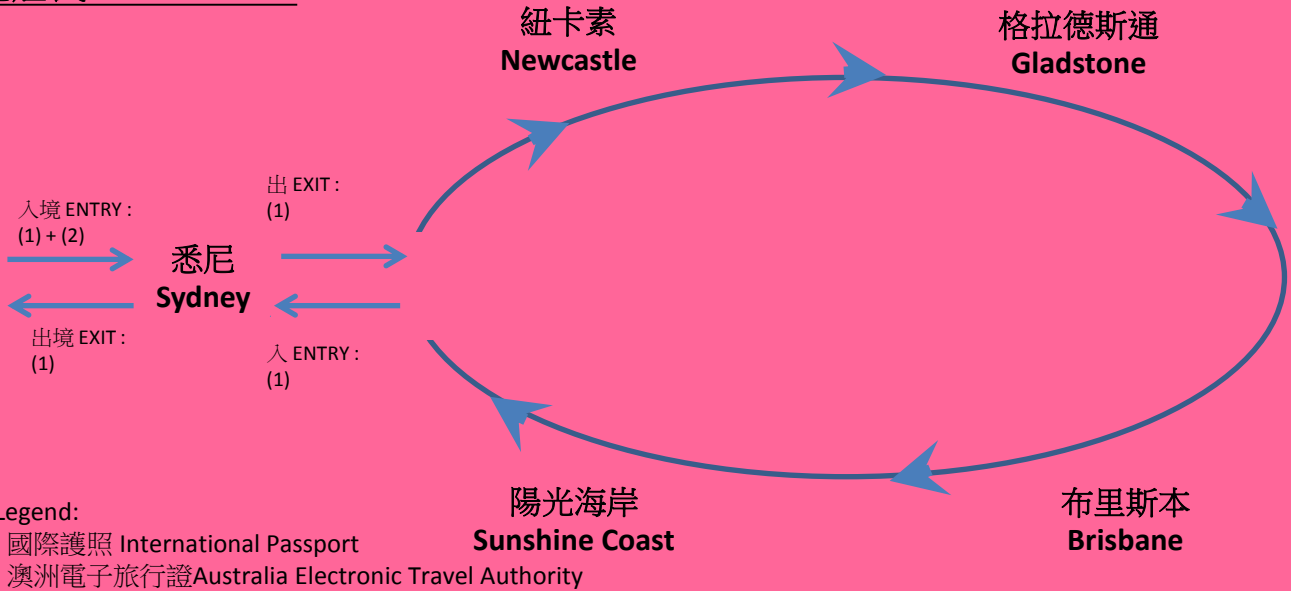

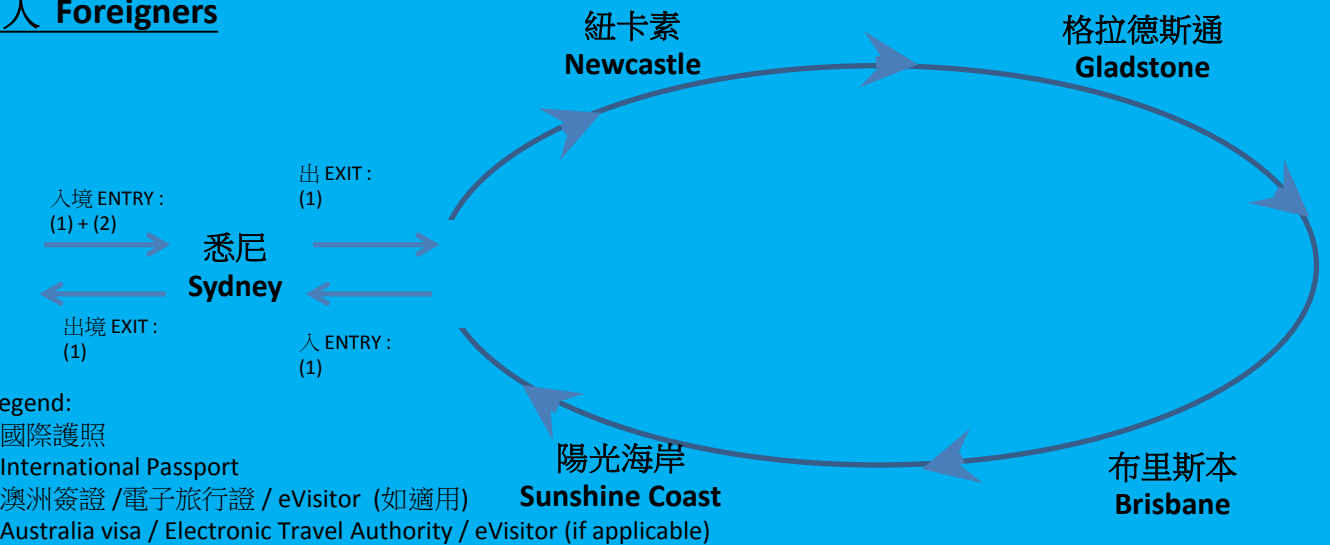

Travel Document Requirement of AU Resident / Citizens

- A. Australian domestic cruises are those calling in only Australian ports and which originate and end in ports within Australia.
- B. All other cruises are considered to be international cruises. These include (but are not limited to) cruises to New Zealand, New Caledonia, Vanuatu, Fiji, Tahiti, Asia and the Caribbean. Australian citizens travelling on international cruises are required to have passports that are valid for at least 6 months after the voyage ends.
