Scenic Railway

Discover North Queensland's natural beauty in two unforgettable ways: on land with a journey aboard the world-famous Kuranda Scenic Railway and from the water aboard a World War II Army Duck. Travel by air-conditioned motor coach to the nearby Freshwater Railway Station and Kuranda Scenic Railway. All aboard your train as you marvel at the scenery climbing up 1,076 feet, past magnificent waterfalls, through 15 tunnels and across 40 bridges. During your 75 minute ascent, an informative commentary will add to the delight of the day's adventure.



Rainforestation

Upon arrival at the Kuranda Railway Station, enjoy a drive through the township of Kuranda and continue by motor coach to the Rainforestation, where you will climb aboard the amphibious Army Duck and become acquainted with some of this World Heritage listed jungle's many residents, including kangaroos, koalas, crocodiles and snakes.

Concluding your wildlife adventure is an exploration of the Koala and Wildlife Sanctuary. Here, you can observe the koalas, wander among the free-roaming kangaroos and wallabies, and pay a visit to the nocturnal display.

Returning to your ship, you will be treated to views of Cairns, the Coral Sea and Green Island as your motor coach makes its way down the mountain.

Tour Highlight :

- **Picturesque mountain retreat and wildlife encounter:** Enjoy the scenic railway journey winds its way through the spectacular World Heritage listed tropical rainforest and Barron Gorge and explore the Koala and Wildlife Sanctuary.
