 <p>Sakurajima Arimura Observatory</p>  <p>Tenmonkan</p>  <p>Yoshino Park</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sakurajima Foot Hot Spring Experience: With Kinko Bay in the front and the magnificent Mount Sakurajima behind, feel the energy of Mother Nature. Immerse your feet in this 100-metre-long foot hot spring and have your fatigue soaked away! • Sakurajima Arimura Observatory: As one of Japan's most active volcanoes and the symbol of Kagoshima. Located in the middle of Kagoshima Bay, volcano is most prominent geographic feature, having an elevation of 1117 meters and a circumference of about 50 kilometers. Before a powerful eruption in 1914, Sakurajima used to be an isolated in the bay, the massive lava flow from that eruption created the volcano's current land connection to the Osumi Peninsula in the east. Enjoy the view onto Sakurajima's craters from the Arimura Observatory and you may see the smokes come out constantly! • Yoshino Park: Located in the northeast part of Kagoshima City, this spacious 30 hectare ground is a nature park covered by lawns and a wide variety of flora and fauna throughout the year. Situated on a 234 meter hill, the splendid overlook offers an unobstructed view of the grand Sakurajima on the other side of Kinko Bay. In days of fine weather, even the Kirishima Range and Kaimondake can be seen in a distance! • Tenmonkan: Known as the most active and prosperous areas in Kagoshima, here your will find retail stores, boutiques, and restaurants offering traditional Kagoshima cuisines and local products.
