Nagasaki is a strategically situated port city on the island of Kyushu and the capital of Nagasaki Prefecture. As one of Japan's closest port cities to the Asian mainland, Nagasaki has played a prominent role in foreign trade relations for centuries. During Japan's period of adopting isolationist foreign policy, Nagasaki was one of the very few ports open to a restricted number of foreign traders. Towards the end of World War II, Nagasaki was the second city after Hiroshima to suffer from an atomic bomb attack.
