

In 1895, a peace conference of the Sino-Japanese War was held at 'Shunpanro' in Shimonoseki, during which a significant Shimonoseki treaty was signed. The hall exhibits the furniture used in the venue, photographs, documents, and more. In particular, the documents by Li Hongzhang, Minister of Culture from Qing Dynasty and by Ito Hirobumi, Minister of the Kingdom of Japan can be seen. • Akama Shrine: The most noticeable feature of Akama Jingu is the large white base that supports one of its many red roofs. This shrine was built to commemorate the spirit of the six-year-old Emperor Antoku, who died here during the decisive Battle of Dan-no-Ura between the Minamoto and Taira clans in 1185. • Karato Market: Enjoy the delicious delicacy of pufferfish uniquely known in Japan! Shimonoseki is famous for fugu or pufferfish, and all kinds of locally-caught seafood can be found on the waterfront at the Karato Fish Market. 

Please note that Shimonoseki one way transfer (no guide service) is sold **ONBOARD ONLY** and transfer starts after all shore excursions have departed. Please visit our shipboard Shore Excursion Counter for departure and return time.

Our coach transfer drop-off point and pick-up point will be at the **Shimonoseki Daimaru**. One way transfer will take approximately 25 minutes. Guests are free to explore the city on your own before boarding the coach at your scheduled time to return to the ship.
