<p>Ba Na Hills Resort: Ba Na Hills is situated nearly 1,500 metres above sea level. Here you can enjoy cool and fresh air, and witness stunning landscapes of the South China Sea and surrounding mountains.</p> <p>Home to a French resort built in the 1920s, the Ba Na hill resort has recently restored and remodelled a few ancient French villas, the Buddhist cultural area, and new hotels and bars. There is a flower garden with various types of aristocratic flowers that Frenchmen left during the past 50 years. First, take the record-breaking cable car (20 minutes ride up to Ba Na Mountain) and enjoy awe-inspiring views of the surrounding forests and mountains. At the peak of the mountain, Ba Na Hills Fantasy Park will meet the entertainment needs of all ages. Golden Bridge with distinctive giant pair of hands sits 1,400 meters above sea level, an altitude which creates the illusion of a silk strip hiding in the clouds above Da Nang.</p>					
 <p>The Bridge of Love & The Carp Dragon (Photo stops): Situated in the East of Han River, 'The Bridge of Love' with hundreds of padlocks on its railing has become a popular attraction of the younger generations. Built next to the stone statue named 'The Carp transforming to a Dragon', here you can also enjoy cool breezes whilst overlooking the Dragon Bridge and Han River Bridge.</p>  <p>Vincom Plaza: A well-known shopping centre in city, gathering branded clothing, supermarket and restaurants. Enjoy free time shopping here!</p>

- **Hue Imperial City:** An intriguing relic of Vietnam's history, recognized as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site in 1993 to signify its historical and cultural importance, restoration has been carried out to recover its overall magnificence, and you will find it a fascinating place to explore. Take the electric cart ride through the city and discover its charms!
- **Imperial Banquet:** Try something unique to Hue! Upon arrival at the traditional restaurant you will be given colourful imperial costumes so you can dress up as Emperors, Queens, Mandarins and Concubines. Entertained by traditional Hue Imperial Court music and served a multiple course meal in the royal tradition of the Imperial Court, you will be amazed by these traditional "royal" delicacies.
- **The Royal Tomb of King Khai Dinh:** Markedly Vietnamese with subtle French influences, the tomb took over a decade to build. It is the most recent and costly amongst other Nguyen Royal Tombs. You can marvel the architecture of the intermingling of orientals and Occidental, Roman and Gothic style, Hindu and Buddhist style, as well as ancient and modern features.
- **Thien Mu Pagoda:** Visit one of the oldest religious structures in Hue and also one of the most impressive. The Pagoda was constructed during the 14th century to worship the legend of a celestial lady. In 1844, Emperor Thieu Tri added the Phuoc Dien stupa. This seven-storey stupa is 21 meters high, with each level dedicated to one of the various human forms taken by Buddha.
- **Boat cruise on Perfume River:** Serenely cruise along the river banks of Perfume River and immerse into the beauty of Hue with the refreshing and tranquil atmosphere.

- The guests will travel at a moderate pace and walk on uneven surfaces with some steps for approximately 2.5 hours. To make your day as enjoyable as possible, we recommend the guests to wear comfortable flat soled shoes, clothing suited to the weather conditions, bring a hat, plenty of sunscreen.
